

Attention El Reno Residents

New System for the Bulk Collection Service

Effective immediately, there is a new system in place for the collection of bulky rubbish.

El Reno residents will be allowed to utilize the landfill once a quarter, under the following conditions:

Proof of residency required for the once a quarter disposal at no charge. Residents may use the landfill by presenting their driver's license and their **current** month El Reno municipal utility bill. Driver's license must match the address on the utility bill. The current utility bill may only be used once each quarter. The original utility bill stub will be retained by OEMA personnel.

Maximum amount of waste disposed would be three (3) cubic yards, approximately the amount that would fit inside a pickup bed. Only household trash or rubbish may be disposed. No construction materials or commercial waste will be accepted. At all other times, regular rates and restrictions of the landfill will be charged.

For residents 70 years of age and older, or residents with houseside service, OEMA personnel will pick up the bulky rubbish under the following terms:

Bulk pick up will be scheduled by calling OEMA's office at least 2 business days prior to the collection day.

Only waste generated at the service address will be collected. No material can be delivered from another address.

No unacceptable waste. This would include, but not limited to tires, appliances with Freon, motor oil, paint, batteries or any hazardous materials.

No items that weigh in excess of 150 pounds. No bulky rubbish will be placed curbside prior to 24 hours before scheduled pick up.

Maximum amount of waste disposed would be three (3) cubic yards, approximately the amount that would fit inside a pick up bed. Any amount over 3 cubic yards would be assessed at \$10 per cubic yard.

For residents that do not have the means to transport to the landfill, OEMA personnel will pick up the bulky rubbish under the following terms:

Bulk pick up will be scheduled by calling OEMA's office at least 2 business days prior to the collection day.

Only waste generated at the service address will be collected. No material can be delivered from another address.

No items that weigh in excess of 150 pounds. No bulky rubbish will be placed curbside prior to 24 hours before scheduled pick up.

No unacceptable waste. This would include, but not limited to tires, appliances with Freon, motor oil, paint, batteries or any hazardous materials.

An assessment of \$10 per cubic yard will be charged.

Disposal times will be the 1st through the 14th day of June, September, December and March, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to noon.
