The subject property is a tract of land lying in the NE/4 of Section thirteen (13), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Eight (8) West of the Indian Meridian in El Reno, Canadian County, Oklahoma.

3. Discussion, consideration, and possible action to approve a Special Event Alcoholic Beverage Permit for Junk Hippy Roadshow for the sale of low-point beer at the Junk Hippy Roadshow event & concert to be held in and around the Denny Crump Arena.
4. Discussion, consideration, and possible action regarding company proposals for new park equipment.
5. Nomination and appointment of a Vice-Mayor.
6. Nomination and appointment of one (1) primary and one (1) alternate to serve on the Community Action Agency Board of Directors for a one-year term set to expire November, 2017.

7. Nomination and appointment of one (1) Council Member as Primary and one (1) as Alternate on the ACOG Board of Directors, one (1) Council Member as Primary and one (1) as Alternate on the ACOG 9-1-1 Board of Directors and one (1) Council Member as Primary and one (1) as Alternate on the Garber-Wellington Board of Directors for a one-year term set to expire November 2017.
