C PUBLIC HEARINGS (no action to be taken during this special joint meeting).

Item No. 2, Solid Waste Collectin Public Hearing was considered first:

1. To conduct a public hearing on the US 81/US 66 intersection conceptual design alternatives.

Opened at 5:21pm and closed at 5:27pm.

This item was presented stating that they had some ways of making the Intersection safe. There would be more discussion on this item at the Regular meeting to be held at 5:30pm immediately following this meeting.

2. To conduct a public hearing on solid waste collection contract renewal.

Opened at 4:33pm and closed at 5:21pm.

This item was presented and there are a few changes. There will be automatic arms which will save on liability and is now the industry standard. There will be many great things such as a cost savings for the public and the potential to have readable chips to show when the trash was picked up. The trash with these new vehicles and new proposal will be street pickup only. The City would like to implement a recycling program (Curb Side). The City is willing to pay for the first 300 residents to sign up in the first year. Each year after, the resident would be responsible. If this grows and works out, we can keep recycling from Curb Side going.

Many questions regarding street pickup were asked. 1. What about the elderly and disabled. Answer: There is already something in place, just call OEMA and they can get trashcans from the house and pull it back up but there are forms to be filed in order to do this. 2. Would some of the routes change? If so, would there be a possibility of picking up on the side of houses when the driveway is not on the main street. Answer: yes, some routes will need to change and some accommodations will be made but it will be a process that everyone will have to work through. 3. The question of people bagging their trash rather than having it loose in the can picked up was brought up especially since it will be in the street and Oklahoma has windy days. Answer: We ask that everyone do that now but and that will not change. 4. The question of when the trucks would run and are there separate trucks for trash and recycling. Answer: There will be separate trucks for trash and recycling and the trucks will most likely run on the same day the trash service runs in that particular neighborhood.
